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Job Description

Key Responsibilities

- To support teachers in the Creative Arts Department with planning, preparation and resources across a range of subject specialisms including Food Technology, workshop-based 3D Design and Art
- To support staff in the preparation and organisation of resources prior to and after lessons. This includes the management and ordering of materials and regular health and safety checks
- Supporting the development of classroom environments across the Creative Arts Department
- To manage the technical, administrative and resource provision across the range of subjects
- To support the department with show/exhibition preparation, exam moderation and other activities and extra-curricular events
- To support aspects of outdoor learning linked to the department curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities
- To provide general administrative support for the department including preparation of materials and displays
- To assist with whole school displays and reprographics
- To prepare, provide and return tools, equipment and materials as necessary to enable staff and students to function effectively
- To carry out routine maintenance of utensils, equipment, machine and hand tools
- To work alongside teaching staff during design and making activities to aid student progress as and when required
- To create and maintain a bank of purchase materials, checking invoices and orders
- To co-ordinate departmental orders, including processing and progressing

It works:

Ark is among the top performing trusts at primary. 78 percent of pupils achieved the expected standard or above in reading, writing, and maths – surpassing the national average of 62 percent by 16 percentage points.

85%

Eighty five percent of our sixth form students go to university at 18, compared to 37 percent nationally. Of those progressing to university, 74% attend a top third university compared to 41 percent nationally.

At secondary, pass rates in maths and English fell nationally by 0.5 percentage points while at Ark pass rates increased by three percentage points.

Disadvantaged students outperformed their peers nationally by this measure by 18 percentage points (61% vs 43.5%).
